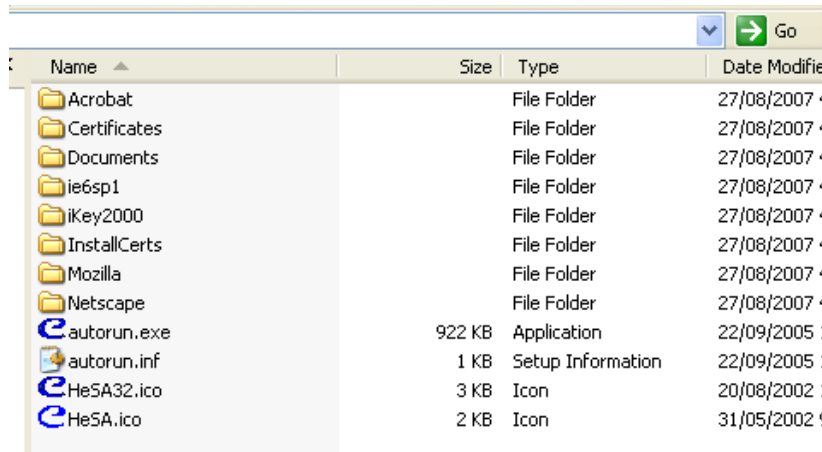


Installation and Configuration of iKey.

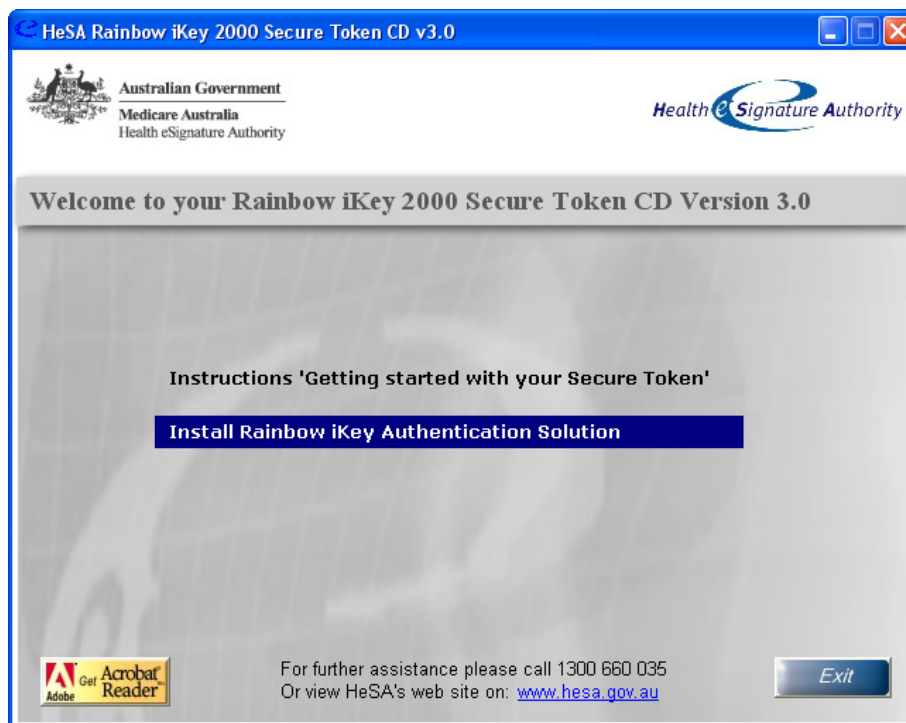
On receipt of your iKey and PIC (Personal Identification Code):

Install Software:

If your CD does not run automatically when inserted in computer, open “my computer”, go to the CD drive (generally d:) and double click *autorun.exe*.



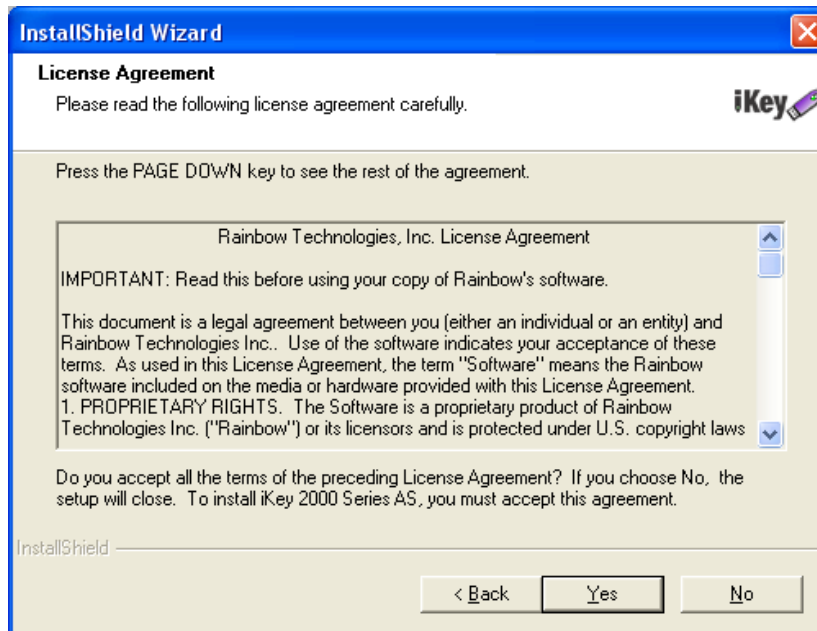
Click “Install Rainbow iKey Authentication Solution”



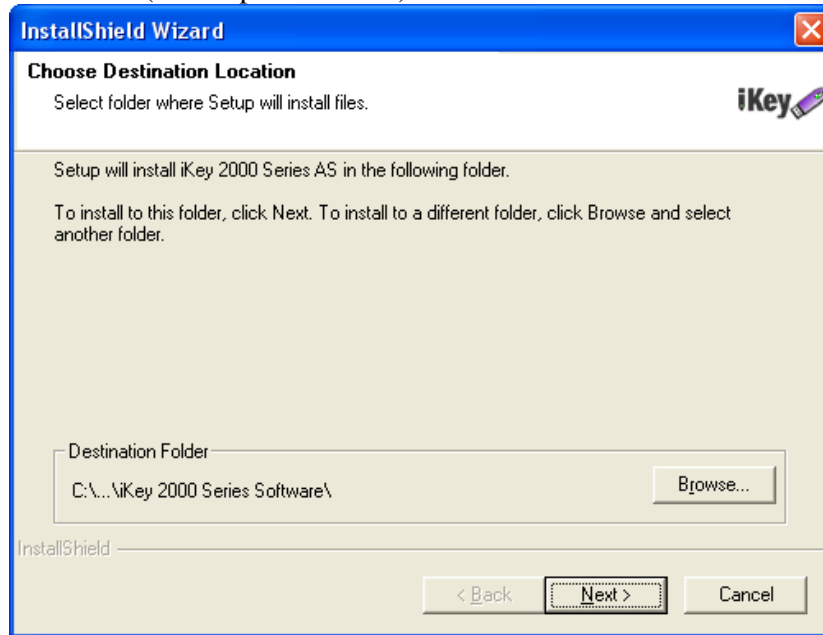


Read and agree to the License Agreement (click “Yes”)

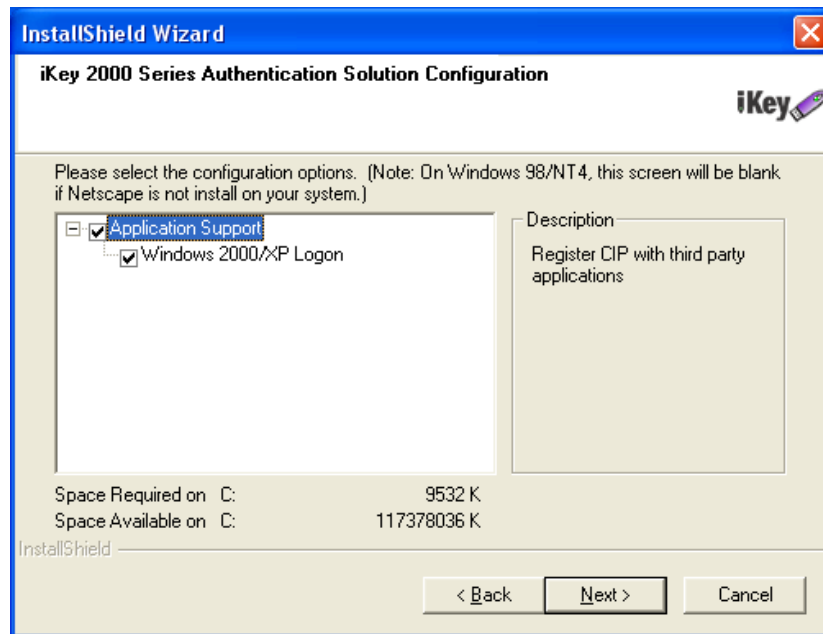

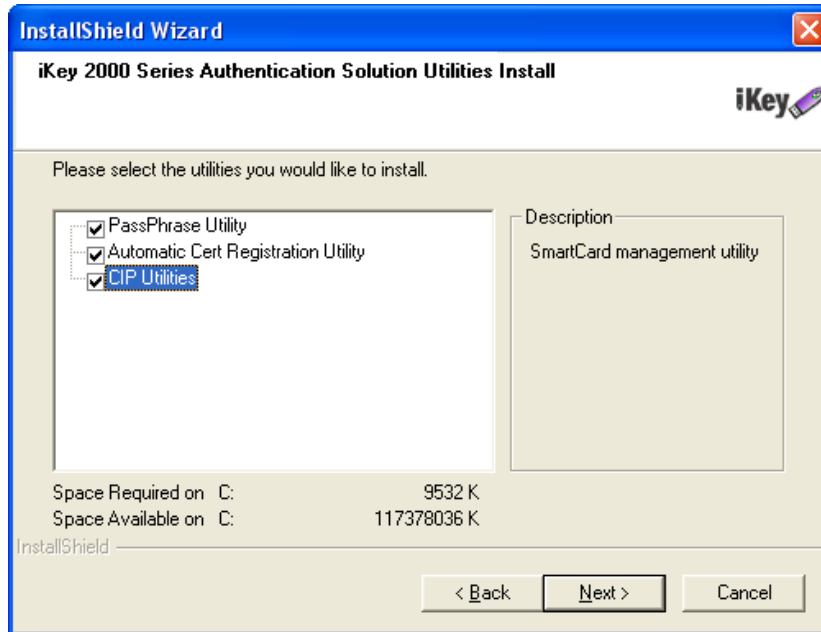
Select a folder to install to (or accept the default) and click next:



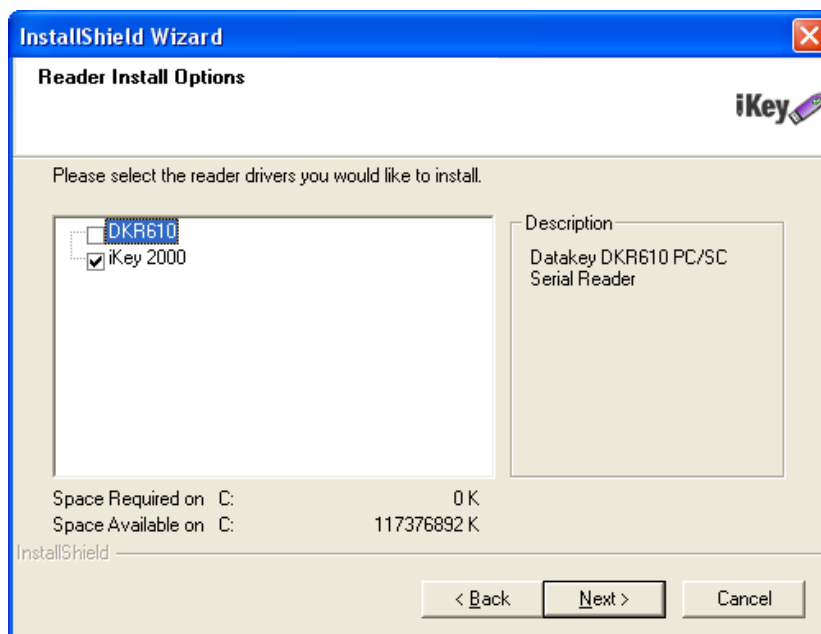
Click Next on the following page:



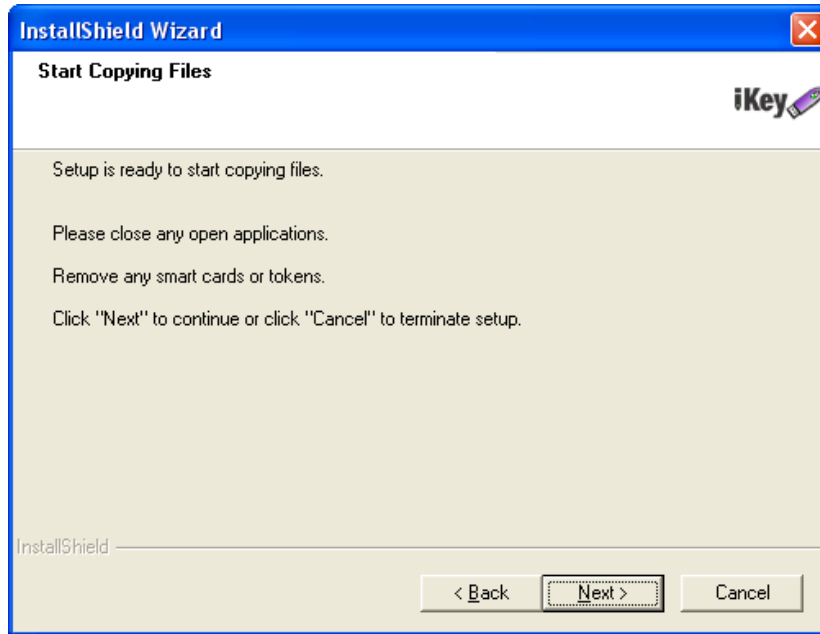
Accept all the default applications to install:



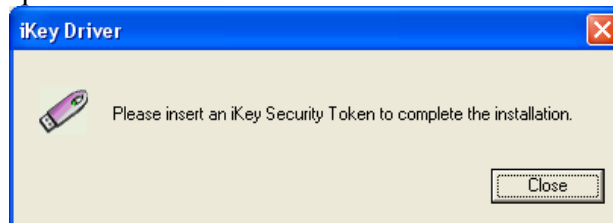
Select the relevant reader that you have been supplied with:



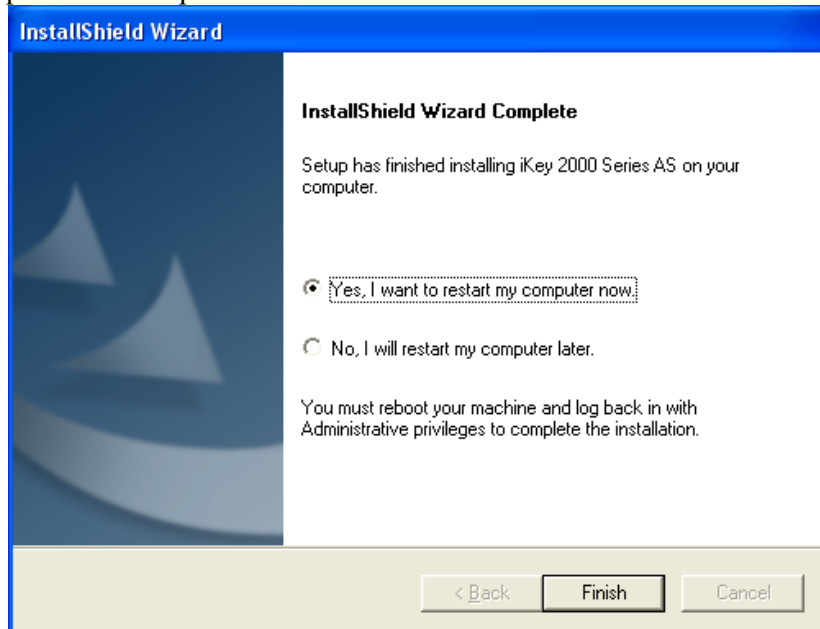
Click Next to start the installation:

Restart the computer when requested:

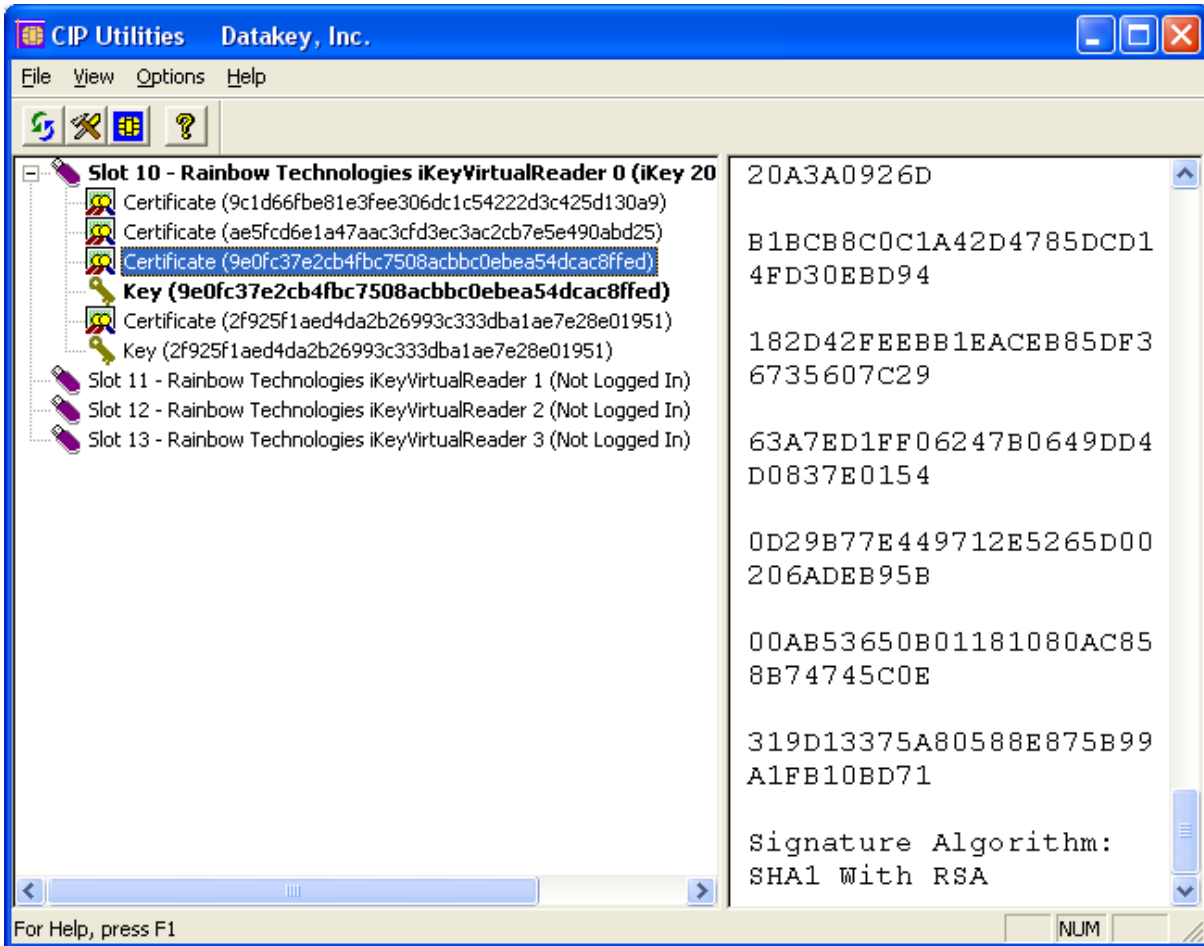


Setup will complete after rebooting.

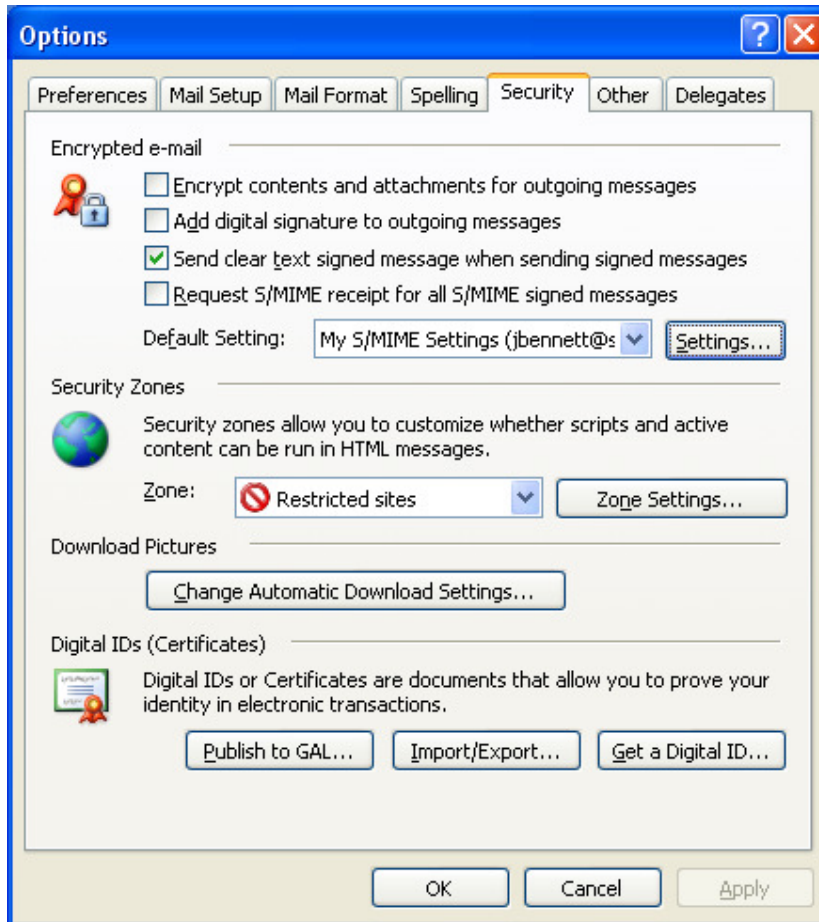

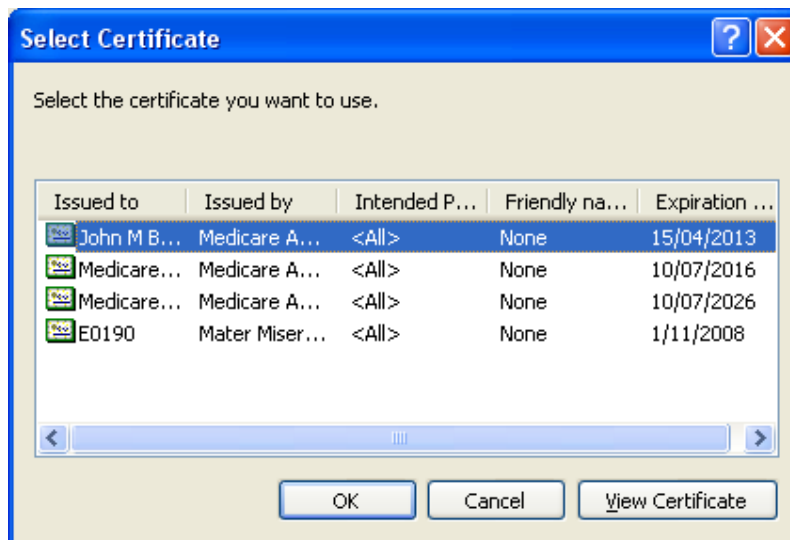
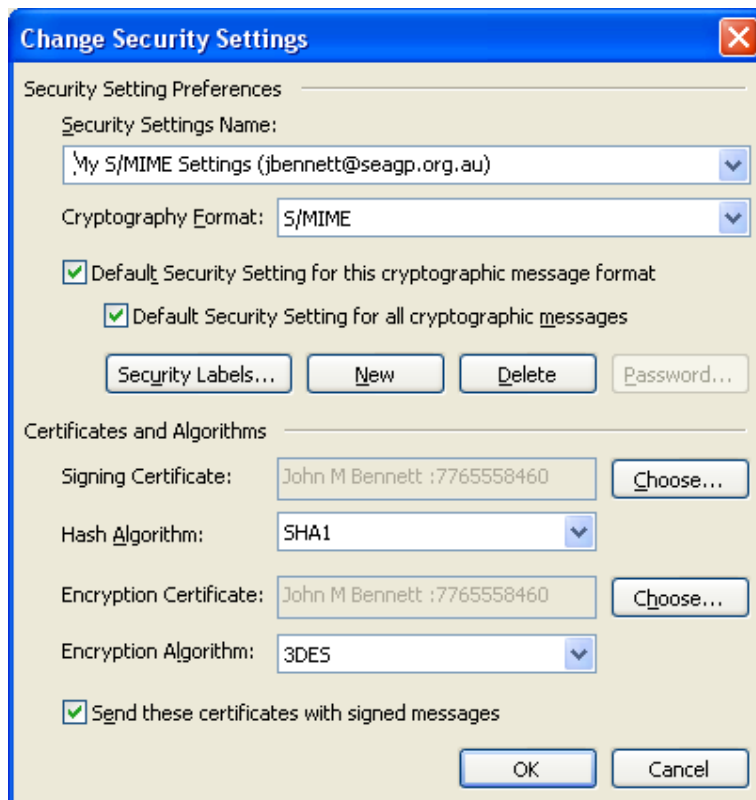
